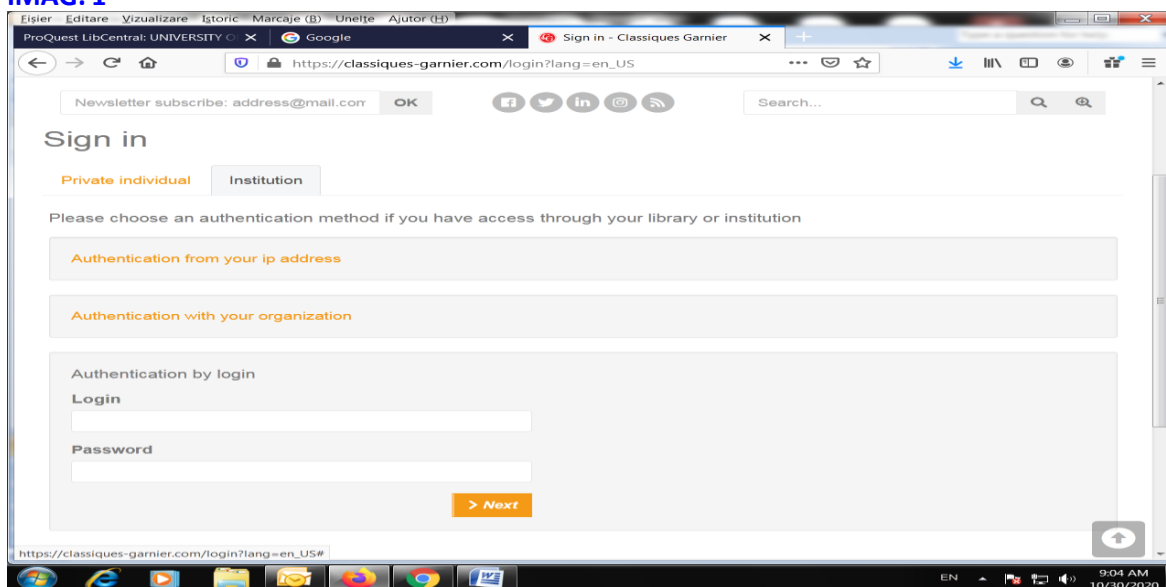

Primul pas pentru a accesa resursele, trebuie să dați click pe https://classiques-garnier.com/login?lang=en_US

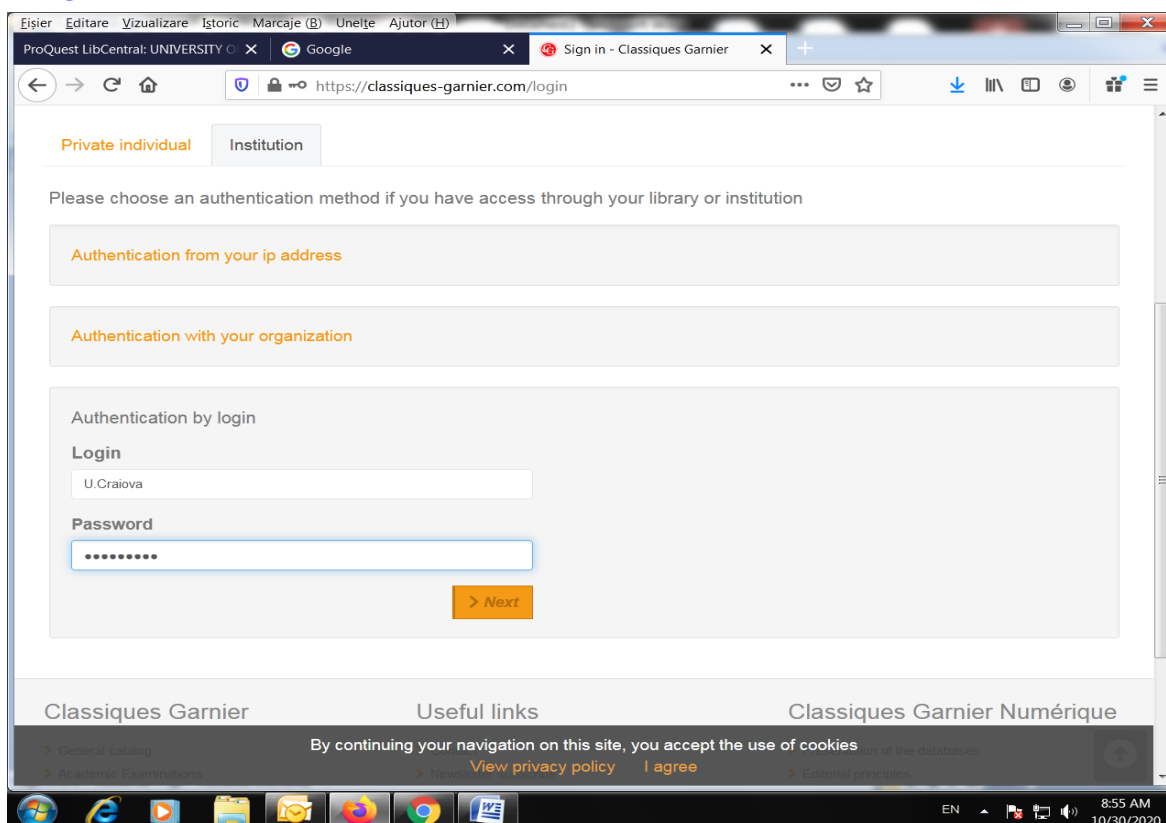
